## FOURTH GRADE SUPPLY LIST 2009-2010



We are looking forward to an exciting school year. We hope to provide a rich and enjoyable experience for your child. The following is a list of supplies needed by each fourth grade student for the 2009-2010 school year. Your child will need these supplies by the first day of school. These supplies may need to be replenished as needed during the school year.

IF YOU ORDERED THE SUPPLY KIT AVAILABLE FROM THE PTA EARLIER IN THE SPRING, your child needs only items 1, 2, and 3.

IF YOU DID NOT ORDER THE SUPPLY KIT, your child needs ALL items 1-24.

1. Emergency clothes and snacks
  2. \$10.00 for agendas, parties
  3. One paint smock or shirt
  4. Two Elmer's Glue (small bottle)
  5. Glue stick
  6. One box of Crayola crayons (24 or less)
  7. Four dozen **sharpened** #2 pencils with erasers (give one box to the teacher)
  8. Five **sharpened** red pencils, or red pens
  9. Plastic School box
  10. One pair Fiskar scissors
  11. Pencil-Top Erasers
  12. Crayola Classic Thick Markers – 8 ct.
  13. 7" 12 CT Crayola Colored Pencils
  14. Two boxes of facial tissue
  15. Two separate spiral notebooks (standard size-about 100 pages): red, green
  16. One pkg. loose-leaf paper (non spiral) standard ruled w/margin line (no college ruled)
  17. One red plastic pocket folders: 1 red
  18. One yellow plastic coated pocket folder
  19. One green plastic coated pocket folder
  20. One purple and one white portfolio with pockets and fasteners for Spanish and Health classes
  21. One black and white composition book
  22. One graphing notebook (spiral filled with graph paper) for Math
  23. Two 1 1/2" hardcover 3-ringed binders
- Please do not bring in large three-ring notebooks or Trappers Keepers or mechanical pencils.
  - Please label all coats, hats, lunch boxes, and school supplies so we can return lost items.
  - Please bring a book from home that you can keep in your desk for leisure reading.
